SENIOR SUBMISSION – SPRING 2018

INFORMATION FOR SENIORS/VETERANS

1. The **Flemington Area Food Pantry** provides food assistance to over 1200 Hunterdon County families. The two requirements necessary to take advantage of the Pantry's services are:

Proof of Hunterdon County residency and Proof of financial need. Bring these proofs to the Pantry during their hours of operation which are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9-11:30, and every other Wednesday evening from 5:30 to 8 p.m., and Saturday morning from 9:30-11:30. The Pantry is located at the back of the Wal-Mart parking lot, accessible by The Link and taxi services. For those unable to visit the location, registration may be done by phone at 908 788-5568. Don't miss out by not checking to see if you are eligible to make use of these services.

2. Tax Break Programs for Seniors and Veterans

Property Tax Reimbursement (Senior Freeze): This Program reimburses eligible senior citizens and disabled persons for property tax increases on their principal residence. Please contact your Tax Assessor for an application and a list of qualifications.

Annual Property Tax Deduction for Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons: An annual deduction of \$250 from property taxes for homeowners aged 65 or older or disabled who meet certain income and residency requirements. Please contact your Tax Assessor for application and income requirements.

Annual Property Tax Deductions for Veterans: An annual deduction of \$250 from property taxes of qualified war veterans and their unmarried surviving spouses/surviving civil union partners/ surviving domestic partners. Please contact your Tax Assessor for application and list of qualifications.

Property Tax Exemption for Disabled Veterans: Full exemption from property taxes on a principal residence for certain totally and permanently disabled war veterans and their unmarried surviving spouses/surviving civil union and domestic partners. Unmarried surviving spouses/surviving civil union and domestic partners of servicepersons who died on wartime active duty may also qualify. Please contact your Tax Assessor for a list of qualifications.

3. Housing Accessibility Rehabilitation (HAR)

HAR is a non-profit organization that helps people with disabilities and seniors to remain in their homes. Their services include, but are not limited to: building ramps, installing grab bars and stair lifts. Please contact HAR at 908 528-4156 for more information.
