

## NO LITTERING OR DUMPING ALLOWED

Please take notice, Ordinance No. 104-04, adopted by Mayor and Council on March 23, 2004 Prohibits Littering and Dumping in the Borough of Bloomsbury. Section # 1 states the purposes of this ordinance and Section # 13 outlines penalties for violations of same. Residents are welcome to view Ordinance No. 104-04, in its entirety at Borough Hall during regular business hours.

### ORDINANCE NO. 104-04

#### AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LITTERING AND DUMPING IN THE BOROUGH OF BLOOMSBURY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bloomsbury, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey:

#### **Section 1. Purposes.**

The purposes of this Ordinance are to:

- A. Prevent the throwing, placing or other disposal of any refuse, rubbish, waste, debris or materials on or in any public street, sidewalk, parking area, public building or other public place in the Borough of Bloomsbury, or upon private property owned by someone else, whereby such action would impede or interfere with the safe, free or unrestricted use of the same by the public or whereby the same might be rendered unsightly in appearance or detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the public.
- B. Require property owners to remove earth, rocks and rubbish from sidewalks abutting their lands.
- C. Prevent accumulation upon property within the Borough of Bloomsbury of brush, ragweed, weeds, dead and dying trees, stumps, roots, obnoxious growths, filth, garbage, automobile bodies or body parts, automobile parts, junk, discarded items such as furniture, machines, appliances or parts thereof, metal, trash and debris and compel the removal or the destruction thereof in order to preserve the public health, safety and general welfare or to eliminate a fire hazard.

#### **Section 13. Violations and Penalties.**

Any person who violates or neglects to comply with any provision of this Ordinance, or any notice or order issued pursuant thereto, shall, upon conviction, be subject to penalties of up to \$1,500.00 in fine and/ or ninety (90) days in jail and/ or 100 hours of community service. In the event a fine is imposed pursuant to this Ordinance, such fine shall be no less than \$250.00. Each day during which a violation of this Ordinance continues shall be deemed a new separate offense.
